From the age of 4 years till the age of 11 year students of PAI ICT Academy learn above mentioned Computer Skills which college students of BCA & BSC Computer Science courses learn in First and Second Year of their studies.

Our students are expert in Corel Draw, Visiting Card, Wedding Card, Comic Book, Broachers, Banners, Pop Art, LOGO Designing and Tracing. Photoshop: Mat painting, 3D Art, Photo Fast, Photo Editing, CD Covers and Photo Album. They are using this skill and earning money and helping financially their parents. Likewise they are using their skills of Robotics and prepared projects using sensors.

PAI – PARVAAZ DIVISION

PAI Parvaaz Division was established in the Year 2016. Under this scheme IT savvy students are identified from their respective schools and brought here at Azam Campus to give them specialised Computer Education and Spoken English skill in addition to their regular school subjects. An altogether different and modern approach is adopted in teaching-learning process. Value added inputs are given to these students.

COMPUTER HARDWARE & NETWORKING ACADEMY

The Computer Hardware & Networking Academy was started in 2011 with a view to compliment and provide technological support to PAI ICT Academy in spreading computer knowledge.

Main activities of computer H/W and N/W Academy :

NAMAZ-E-JUMA

(Preparing students to lead Juma Namaz)

There is a separate Central Deeniyat Department in the Campus. Muslim students of the Campus are imparted religious knowledge and Quran education. From this year an innovative programme was launched, under which capable students of our schools are prepared to lead Juma prayer (imamat), to deliver Juma sermons (khutba) in Arabic and also speeches in English and Urdu and also to give call for prayer (Azan). ❖ M.A. RANGOONWALA TALENT SEARCH & PROMOTION SCHEME ❖

It was felt for a long time that the girls and boys of the Muslim community though have potential to excel do not fare well in various competitive examinations due to lack of expert coaching. Keeping this in view the scheme called Scholar Batch, was started at Azam Campus from 15th April'1999.

The students are enrolled for the Std. XI and XII Science and prepared for Board Examinations. They are also prepared for the various competitive examinations. The admission to medical and paramedical, dental, pharmacy, architecture, I.I.T and many other courses are made on the basis of competitive examinations held at State and National level.

Merely scoring at XII examination is not sufficient to secure admissions to MBBS, BDS, BAMS, BHMS, BUMS and other paramedical and engineering courses. Keen competition requires not only knowledge skill but also self-confidence and positive attitude which make a big difference. Overall development of the students is also our objective.

The scholar batch thus tries to cater to the intellectual needs of the students and provide them opportunities to formulate bright careers, to enhance their performance at the HSC examination.

The Scholar Batch's passing percentage has always been 100%.

❖ ERP SYSTEM OF AZAM CAMPUS ❖


Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) System

At present Madrasa students are left out of mainstream education system and cannot pursue career in fields other than Islamic Studies, as they do not fulfill minimum prescribed educational qualifications. Not only that they also face difficulties in day to day life as they do not possess documents such as leaving certificate, educational certificate that are recognized by the Government.

To overcome this, M.C.E. Society has initiated a special scheme named as "PAI Madrasa Development Scheme" to guide and support madrasa students to register themselves for Std. X (S.S.C.) and Std. XII (H.S.C.) at NOIS study center at Azam Campus and pursue higher education and become an asset to the community and the nation.

During the year 120 Madrasa students appeared for std. X (S.S.C.) and 30 Madrasa students appeared for std. XII (H.S.C.) conducted by NOIS. Entire expenses of these madrasa students were borne by the M.C.E. Society.

❖ DINING ETIQUETTE WORKSHOP ❖

M.C.E Society's M.A. Rangoonwala Institute of Hotel Management and Research conducted One Day Workshops on "Dining Etiquettes" for the students studying in the schools and colleges in Azam Campus at its state of the art restaurants.

Around 1050 were trained during the year 2018-2019.

The workshop mainly focused on educating the students on dining etiquettes and lifestyle management. Besides learning, how to sit and eat a meal in a formal dining set-up, students were also taught about good eating habits, stress management and responsible behavior on social media. An excellent presentation, demonstration and practice sessions were organized. Arrangements were made to create actual ambience and to bring great realism into the whole exercise by setting up dining tables and providing refreshments. Students were given insights on the importance of nutrition and implementation of a healthy lifestyle with know-how on physical exercise.

The workshop was a refreshing and a new experience for many students, and it changed the general perspective about fine dining. It also promoted 'Eat Right' movement of the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India. The students emerged as better-informed gentlemen and ladies who would not feel intimidated by all the technical and exquisite terms one needs to know about when they talk about fine dining.





SPECIAL COACHING PROGRAMME TO PREPARE SSC (ATKT) STUDENTS FOR RE-EXAMINATION JULY 2019

The S.S.C.E. Board conducts supplementary Examination in July every year for the students who have failed in examination (ATKT) conducted in March. If a student clears the subjects (ATKT) his admission to Std. XIth is continued and confirmed thus saving his one year.

MCE Society has introduced a scheme under which special coaching is imparted to such ATKT students to help them clear their backlog subjects. The coaching classes were conducted at Anglo Urdu Boys High School from 25th June to 13th July 2019, which was attended by 165 students from various schools in Pune ,namely Anglo Urdu Boys' High School, Anglo Urdu Girl's High School, M.C.E S English Medium School, Rafiahmed Kidwai School, Moledina High School, Lady Tahirunnisa Inamdar and Dr.(Mrs.) N.D Nagarwala school. Out of 165 ATKT students 115 students cleared SSC Examination in July 2019


The cell take continuous follow ups of the scholarship forms filled up by students and has been successful in helping students getting various national as well as international scholarships worth crores of rupees till date.
